### Common Themes from Open House #1 & #2 (October/November 2017)

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sidewalks are too close to the roadway</li> <li>• Sidewalks are not well-maintained</li> <li>• Not enough space to store snow</li> <li>• High traffic volumes and speeds making crossing the road difficult</li> <li>• Traffic is noisy and sometimes causes vibrations/impacts to property</li> </ul>	<p><b>Pedestrians</b></p> <p><b>Transit Users</b></p> <p><b>Adjacent Property Owners</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pedestrians do not feel safe walking along or across the corridor, or waiting for a bus</li> <li>• Poor maintenance makes walking difficult, so people don't use the sidewalks</li> <li>• Unhappy homeowners</li> <li>• Compromised sense of community</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Traffic volumes and speeds discourage bicycling</li> <li>• Not enough space for bicycling</li> </ul>	<p><b>Bicyclists</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bicyclists do not feel safe in the corridor</li> <li>• Those who may wish to bike, do not</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Too much delay and congestion</li> <li>• High traffic volumes make it difficult to cross the corridor and turn from/onto the corridor</li> <li>• Signal Timing slows down corridor traffic</li> <li>• Signal Maintenance issues</li> </ul>	<p><b>Drivers</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Affects mobility and travel time; drivers may seek alternative routes through neighborhoods</li> <li>• Increased crashes/conflicts</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Not enough parking near businesses</li> </ul>	<p><b>Parking</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Unhappy business owners &amp; patrons</li> <li>• Neighborhood impacts from overflow parking</li> </ul>
